

National Series

We currently publish three complete series of historical maps of England & Wales: the *Cassini Old Series (OSE)*, the *Cassini Revised New Series (RNC)* and the *Cassini Popular Edition (POP)*. Each Cassini map was created by digitally combining parts of several original Ordnance Survey sheets, not all of which were first published in the same year: these date ranges are shown below.

To specify the map you need when ordering, please quote the **series code (OSE, RNC or POP)** and the the three-figure **map code** of the area you require.

Thus OSE-150 is the Cassini Old Series map of Worcester & The Malverns, created from maps first published between 1828 and 1832;

POP-075 is the Cassini Popular Edition map of Berwick-upon-Tweed, created from maps first published in 1926.

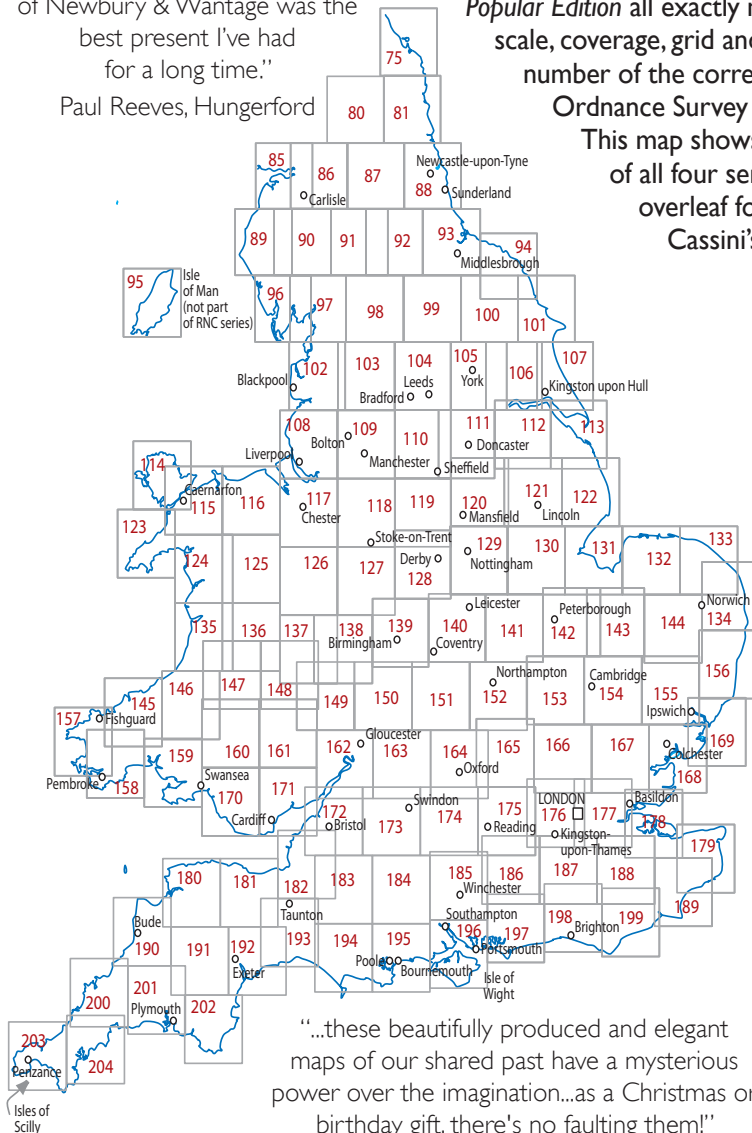

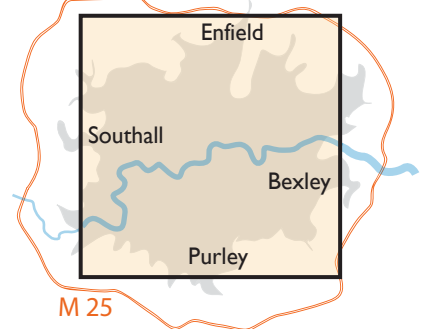

London Historical Maps Series

These maps explore the history of the capital between the early 19th century and the late 1940s. There are four maps in all, each covering the same 40km x 40km area at a scale of 1:50,000 (the same as the OS Landrangers®) and centred on Charing Cross. They are available individually, as a box set of all four maps (which also includes a 1:10,000 street map of Central London in 1891) or as rolled maps in tubes suitable for framing.
